Tasting Notes

This delicious, dry white is a dual varietal made with Piquepoul and Terret grapes, grown overlooking the oyster beds of the Bassin de Thau in the South of France. It is both light and fruity, with less acidity that a classic Picpoul wine making it ideal for summer.

Delightfully refreshing served chilled on its own or with al fresco dining.
