Winemaking

This wine is made using traditional methods, only the best quality grapes are selected. Hand-picked grapes are de-stemmed and then macerated for 8 hours before pressing. The grape must is fermented in stainless steel at 17°C and kept on their lees for 2 months before bottling to add subtle flavours to the wine. The wine is unoaked.

Tasting Notes

Open, Pour & Explore this classic Sauvignon Blanc from Vallé Central, Chile. Crisp and aromatic with tropical aromas of grapefruit and passion fruit. Ripe, citrus fruit flavours give a refreshing and balanced wine. Served chilled on its own or with seafood, poultry, light pasta dishes or salads.

Encapsulating the very essence of what gives Australian family-owned wineries a great reputation today, the wine is made by a thriving family owned winery in South Australia who have built an enviable reputation for consistently making quality wines that are generous in flavour and superbly drinkable. Grapes were selected from vineyards across the region with the natural variation that occurs between the vineyard sites and soil types producing parcels of fruit that are distinct in their aroma, taste and texture. They were machine harvested at night when they were at their optimum maturity. The harvested grapes were carefully vinified and given a short time in oak to produce a wine that is fresh and lively with good fruit characteristics.

Tasting Notes

Open, pour and explore this classic Chardonnay from South Eastern Australia. Generous and soft with ripe fruit flavours of peach and melon and a hint of vanilla. This ripe, fresh wine is well balanced with a long finish. Served chilled on its own or with roast chicken, creamy pasta dishes or herb salads.

Winemaking

Grapes are carefully selected, harvested and pressed immediately to preserve flavour and colour. The wine is fermented at 14°C and arrested at the right moment to assure a good natural structure. As a result, the wine tastes fresh and luscious with good fruit flavours. Located in the northern part of California's Central Valley, Lodi is recognised for its unique and distinctive quality Zinfandel wines. Noted for its classic Mediterranean climate and distinctive sandy soils, this region is perfectly suited for premium wine growing and the production of world class wine.

Tasting Notes

Open, Pour & Explore this classic White Zinfandel from California, USA. Lively and refreshing flavours of ripe strawberry and juicy watermelon combine with a delicate sweetness and crisp acidity. Served chilled on its own or with pork, chicken, salads or creamy soft cheeses.

Winemaking

Encapsulating the very essence of what gives Australian family-owned wineries a great reputation today, the wine is made by a thriving family owned winery in South Australia who have built an enviable reputation for consistently making quality wines that are generous in flavour and superbly drinkable. The grapes are crushed, pressed and fermented at temperatures of 26-27°C. Grape juice is left in contact with the skins for 5-7 days to enrich flavour and colour. The fermented wine is stored for 3 months in oak.

Tasting Notes

Open, Pour & Explore this classic Shiraz from South Eastern Australia. Rich and fruity with ripe black fruit flavours of cherry and plum with hints of spice, pepper and vanilla. It is medium bodied and has a long finish. Serve at room temperature with peppered steak, robust pasta dishes or roasted vegetables.



Compass Point Malbec Argentina

Winemaking

The desert-like conditions in Mendoza allied to an extremely effective irrigation system have helped take Mendoza to the very top with their Malbec wines. Hailing from a winery founded in 1915, the grapes were hand-picked during the first week of April, before being fermented in temperature controlled tanks to bring the perfect balance to this excellent wine.

Tasting Notes

Open, Pour & Explore this classic Mendoza Malbec. Complex aromas of dark berry fruits, alongside soft hints of chocolate, coffee and tobacco. This generous wine is well balanced with intense flavours of red and black fruits and a long finish, ripe tannins confirm that this is a wine that will age well. Serve on it's own or with red meat dishes, this opulent red pairs particularly well with barbecued steak.
