Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains', as the dry and dusty area gives no clues to the wonderful wines it can produce. The grapes for this Reserve Malbec are sourced from a family owned winery in Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo, which is considered to have the best terroir in Mendoza for growing this wine. It is made by Juan Pablo Murgia, an internationally acclaimed winemaker.

Winemaking

Grapes are handpicked from selected 30+ year old vines. Traditional fermentation is followed by the malolactic fermentation, before the wine is skilfully blended.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of ripe black fruit, leather and tobacco spice. Full-bodied with flavours of blackberry, damson and roasted spicy notes of pepper and cinnamon. Ripe tannins provide structure and length in the mouth.

Ideal with cheese, stews, red meat and richly flavoured dishes. Try with an Argentine 'Asado' for authentic BBQ inspired food

Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains' and Malbec wines from the region of Mendoza are the jewel in the crown.

Wine Making

Specially selected grapes are transported to the winery where they are fermented with rich, oaky flavours before being stored in state-of-the-art stainless steel containers to ensure that all of the trademark Malbec flavours are enhanced further before bottling.

Tasting Notes

This robust red from Argentina has aromas of ripe black fruits, prune and leather. On the palate it is soft and mellow, with flavours of plum, prune and damson and a touch of liquorice.

Best served at room temperature this wine is a great partner with steak, burgers and roasted red meats, richly sauced pasta dishes or pizza.

Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains' and this couldn't be more true than in Chile where the cool, clear water from the Andes helps to irrigate the vineyards below.

Wine Making

This wine is made using traditional methods, only the best quality grapes are hand selected for this process. The fermentation takes place at low temperatures, in stainless steel vats, to preserve the fruit and freshness in the wine. This wine has been lightly oaked.

Tasting Notes

A fresh and vibrant Chilean Chardonnay that exhibits complex citrus notes, lifted tropical fruit flavours and a balanced minerality with subtle creamy undertones.

Best served chilled, this delicious wine will suit numerous occasions. It partners well with seafood or chicken dishes, avocado salads and creamy risottos.
