Wine Making

This wine is made using traditional methods, only the best quality grapes are selected. The fermentation takes place at low temperatures, in stainless steel vats, to preserve the fruit, freshness and concentration in this wine. This wine is not aged in oak and is bottled young to ensure that it is fresh and fruity.

Tasting Notes

An elegant, rich and fruity Merlot from Chile's Valle Central. Intense fruit flavours of cherry and plum intertwine with sumptuous aromas of coffee and chocolate.

Best served at room temperature this wine will partner well with grilled pork loin, roast lamb or tomato based dishes.

Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains' and Malbec wines from the region of Mendoza are the jewel in the crown.

Wine Making

Specially selected grapes are transported to the winery where they are fermented and then stored in state-of-the-art stainless steel containers to ensure that all of the trademark Malbec flavours are enhanced further before bottling.

Tasting Notes

Jam packed with generous aromas of blackberries and blueberries. This wine gives rise to juicy, ripe dark fruits on the palate with hints of liquorice and clove, evolving into a sumptuously mellow finish.

Serve at room temperature with roast lamb, burgers, burritos or blue cheese.

Wine Making

This wine is made using traditional methods, only the best quality grapes are selected. The fermentation takes place at low temperatures, in stainless steel vats, to preserve the fruit and freshness in the wine. This liquid is lees aged for 2 months before bottling to ensure subtle flavours are added to the wine.

Tasting Notes

This delightfully crisp and zesty Sauvignon Blanc combines ripe citrus and gooseberry with herbaceous notes of grass and lemon verbena.

Serve chilled on its own, or with roast chicken, fresh shellfish, or a herby salad.

Wine Making

Made from hand-picked Syrah grapes grown in Chile's warm climate and picked earlier for a lower ABV. A short maceration extracts a higher concentration of flavours, then the grapes are gently pressed to create a pale pink rosé full of red fruit aromas.

Tasting Notes

Delicate aromas of red fruit - strawberries, cherries and redcurrants – combine with hints of citrus and a light sweetness on the palate, balanced with refreshing acidity.

Perfect with a picnic, a niçoise or caprese salad, or vegetable skewers.
