Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains', as the dry and dusty area gives no clues to the wonderful wines it can produce. The grapes for this Reserve Malbec are sourced from an award-winning winery and the wine has been expertly crafted by a wine maker with over 35 years of experience.

Winemaking

Grapes are handpicked from selected vines. This liquid is then skilfully blended during traditional fermentation and oaked to produce an outstanding, multi-award winning wine.

Tasting Notes

Aromas of ripe black fruit, leather and tobacco spice. Full-bodied with flavours of blackberry, damson and roasted spicy notes of pepper and cinnamon. Ripe tannins provide structure and length in the mouth.

Ideal with cheese, stews, red meat and richly flavoured dishes. Try with an Argentine 'Asado' for authentic BBQ inspired food

Background

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains' and Malbec wines from the region of Mendoza are the jewel in the crown.

Wine Making

Specially selected grapes are transported to the winery where they are fermented with rich, oaky flavours before being stored in state-of-the-art stainless steel containers to ensure that all of the trademark Malbec flavours are enhanced further before bottling.

Tasting Notes

This robust red from Argentina has aromas of ripe black fruits, prune and leather. On the palate it is soft and mellow, with flavours of plum, prune and damson with a touch of liquorice.

Best served at room temperature this wine is a great partner with steak, burgers and roasted red meats, richly sauced pasta dishes or pizza.

El Tesoro de las Montañas means 'The Treasure of the Mountains' and this richly textured Chardonnay is a prime example of some of the single varietal stars that are available from this dynamic wine growing region.

Wine Making

Handpicked Chardonnay grapes are carefully transported from the vineyards to be fermented in stainless steel tanks at a chilled temperature so that the complex flavour of these grapes can be fully expressed in this excellent wine.

Tasting Notes

This fruity Argentinean Chardonnay has aromas of tropical fruits and lightly toasted notes. It is a fresh and easy drinking wine, with an underlying minerality that creates a delightful balance and mouthfeel.

Best served chilled, this wine is a perfect partner for light chicken dishes, creamy pasta recipes and herby green salads.

Wine Making

This wine is made using traditional methods, only the best quality grapes are selected. The fermentation takes place at low temperatures, in stainless steel vats, to preserve the fruit, freshness and concentration in this wine. This wine is not aged in oak and is bottled young to ensure that it is fresh and fruity.

Tasting Notes

An elegant, rich and fruity Merlot from Chile's Valle Central. Intense fruit flavours of cherry and plum intertwine with sumptuous aromas of coffee and chocolate.

Best served at room temperature this wine will partner well with grilled pork loin, roast lamb or tomato based dishes.

This liquid is lees aged for 2 months before bottling to ensure subtle flavours are added to the wine.

Tasting Notes

A delightful Sauvignon Blanc from Chile's Valle central. Zesty and refreshing with tropical fruit flavours of gooseberry, passionfruit and hints of mouth-watering fresh lime.

Best served chilled this wine will partner well grilled and barbecued chicken, light seafood dishes and citrus salads.

Tasting Notes

A fresh and vibrant Chilean Chardonnay that exhibits complex citrus notes, lifted tropical fruit flavours and a balanced minerality with subtle creamy undertones.

Best served chilled, this delicious wine will suit numerous occasions. It partners well with seafood or chicken dishes, avocado salads and creamy risottos.
